#### Sacred Circle Yoga and Meditation Spring Series:

The Yamas of Yoga (Six-week Session)

The *yamas* are the ethical principles that guide the physical practice of yoga and encourage a "right way of living". Patricia Barrier, registered yoga teacher, will begin each class with instruction on a *yama* that will inform our

gentle yoga practice and end with a short meditation helping us to apply that principle to our daily life. In this way, we move from the physical practice to a living yoga that guides our actions and helps us to grow spiritually. The class is suitable for beginners as well as those experienced in yoga who wish to deepen their practice. All aspects of the practice are adaptable to a chair or can be done with assistive devices. Yoga equipment is provided or bring your own mat.

The six-week series will occur on the following dates: **Tuesday May 28th, June 4th, 11th, 18th, 25th and July 2 from 5:30-6:30 pm in Crawford Hall**.
